1. Committee Members - The committee will consist of 9 members. The Board of Christian School representative will serve as chairperson. Other members will be the band director, vocal music teacher, children's hand bell director, art teacher, 2 parents (as per PTL election), and 2 students (from grades 6 - 8 as per faculty recommendation). The parents would serve 2-year staggered terms. All appointments are subject to approval by the Board of Christian School.
2. Basic Purpose - To assist in providing an extracurricular fine arts program that will give the students an opportunity to grow in faith in their Lord Jesus Christ through art, drama, and music and to share their faith in God through the expression of such within our school, church, and community.
3. Authority - The committee is responsible to the Board of Christian School.
4. Communication - The committee is to act as a liaison between the Board of Christian School and the fine arts staff, and between the Board and parents.
5. Policy - Assist the Board of Christian school in the formation of policies affecting the extracurricular fine arts program.
6. Advisory - Serve as an advisory group for the fine arts staff.
7. Financial - Present an annual budget from the fine arts staff to the Board of Christian School.
8. Tasks - Assist the fine arts staff and the Board of Christian School in the performance of special tasks that enhance, enrich, maintain, and/or expand our extracurricular fine arts program.
