We believe at Trinity Lutheran School that every child has a right to an education. The cost of an education at Trinity is funded through tuition. Members of Trinity Lutheran Church receive a member tuition rate while anyone else enrolling in Trinity Lutheran School receives a non-member rate.

We do know that there are some families who wish to have their child here, but have a difficult time with that tuition. Therefore, we do offer some scholarship assistance. We utilize a service called *School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSFA)*. There are applications to be filled out and sent to the SSSFA Company. The cost for the application and processing is \$20.00.

If a family wishes to be considered for financial assistance, the forms (which are available in mid January) need to be picked up in the school office. The process, once the form is received by the company, takes three weeks to be returned to the school.

The deadline to request an application will be April 15. No applications will be handed out after that deadline. Applications are to be submitted to SSFA on or before May 15 to be considered for scholarships awarded on July 15.

Anyone submitting an application for scholarship assistance, must check first with their congregation and see if they give any aid. Any aid must be declared to Trinity Lutheran School prior to consideration for scholarship assistance.
