

## Trinity Parent Teacher League Meeting 4/15/2019

Opened with prayer.

### **Treasurer Report:**

The treasurer reported that PTL is on track for funds to roll-over for next school year. Additionally, PTL received about \$110 from the recent TLS/Speedeezz night. There will be a TLS/Orange Leaf (SW side) night on May 14<sup>th</sup> to coincide with the Choir/Band concert.

### **Committee Reports:**

American History Festival: The festival was well attended. Jodi commented that the committee did a great job. Mrs. Fischer commented that having the festival at this time worked better for the teachers. TLS is still waiting on a donation from Kohl's, but so far, profits are around \$5,200.

Teacher Appreciation Week: Alyssa Levisay reported that the committee will be decorating the halls. Also, children will write thank yous to their teachers. Robyn Rasmussen has a large stack of thank you notes which she will donate. A suggestion was made that a card be given to the teachers showing what events will occur during Teacher Appreciation Week. Teacher Appreciation Week is May 6-10.

Plant Sale: Isle of Green will be supplying plants this year. There is not an increase in price, but there are adjustments as to how plants are potted, ie 4 pack this year instead of 3 inch pot due to the change in nurseries. The variety is slightly more than last year. Christa has put up the bulletin board. Additionally, Christa has come up with the idea to make plant sales a contest between grades. Whichever grade has the most orders will get a pizza party. Christa will have thermometers on the bulletin board so that the children can see how they're doing compared to the other classes. The plants should be delivered the afternoon of Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. We will ask the teachers of the middle school children if the children can help unload the plants. Christa will let Kelly know details for the Sign Up Genius. In the past, tarps have been borrowed from Amanda Freese's mother. Christa will

have Laura Holt check on those. Flats for plants can be brought in May 3<sup>rd</sup>, after the Operetta.

Blue Book Exchange: Alyssa Levisay reported that this has been well received. The program will end the last week of April which will allow the coordinators to evaluate the condition of the books. Amy Annett and Shelley Rose offered for Alyssa to look through their children's books for possible donations. Anyone else who has possible book donations should contact Alyssa Levisay.

Box Tops: Robyn Rasmussen is taking over as coordinator for Box Tops. She recently learned that packages will no longer have physical box tops. Now, it will be on an app. Robyn will relay information about how to redeem Box Tops. TLS usually gets around \$1,000/year from this program.

It has been suggested that Pat Powell will help the Treasurer with tasks such as depositing money from PTL events, snack sales, etc. Jana Pownell stated that the School Board will include PTL in the overall budget. If PTL spends over an amount to be determined, a purchase order will need to be made. At tonight's meeting, a vote was taken for a verbal okay to use the business office resources in managing PTL money. This was approved.
